2024 Scholarship Essay Contest

Submission Deadline: May 10, 2024

Introduction:

Information:

Students submitting essays grant XLL Chapter the right to keep the essay and exercise full publishing rights. The decisions of the judges are final and the awards will be announced on **June 1**st. Awards will be distributed to each winner upon written verification of enrollment from an institution of higher learning.

Essay Topic:

"What impact will artificial intelligence (AI) technology have on higher education?"

Rating Criteria for 650 - 750 Word Essay:

- Development of Topic/Thesis (30 possible pts.) Topic well developed
- Progression (20 possible pts.) Composition progresses from beginning to end in a logical flow of information
- Readability (25 possible pts.) Concise prose that sticks to the point and does not ramble
- Grammar (15 possible pts.) Agreement of subject and verb; proper tense; correct sentence construction; paragraphing, including transitional phrases.
- Spelling (5 possible pts.)
- Punctuation (5 possible pts.)
